I. Use & applicable range

It is a convertible vehicle using for lifting and transporting in workshop, warehouse and wharf, etc.

III. Characteristics

This cart adopts mechanical change structure to lift the table by low speed or fast speed. When the loading is light, you can foot the pedal to lift the table by fast speed way. It is about twelve times to lift the table to the max height. When the loading is much heavy, you can foot the pedal to lift the table by low speed way. It is about thirty-five times to lift the table to the max height. You can change the lift speed according to different loading.

IV. Assembly

- 4. Insert handle (#12) into the hole of the frame seat (#26), and then fix them by two hex cap bolts M10.
- 5. The brake thread (#13) through the hole of the press board (#19), adjust the degree of tightness and then fix them by Nut (#24).
- 6. Insert the foot pedal rod (#44) into the hole of the foot pedal support (#42), and fix them by screw.


V. Using

- 1. Please debug the cart before using: Step on the foot pedal rod equably to lift the table.
- 2. Please lock the brake on the wheel and fix the table before loading.
- 3. Please load goods in its rate capacity. You can load or discharge after the table to the height which you need by step the foot pedal.
- 4. Please use the brake handle (#14) to lower down the table.

VI. Warning!

- 1 Operate strictly according to the instruction manual.
- 2. Do not use the cart on slop.
- 3. Do not allow people to sit or ride on the cart.
- 4. Do not transport the loads during the raising process.
- 5. Do not random regulate the safety valve.
- 6. The maintenance is to be performed by the professional personnel strictly according to the related information of the instruction manual.
- 7. Keep oil clean. Check the oil reservoir in the hydraulic cylinder before operate and replenish reservoir if oil does not reach 2/3 of the capacity.
- 8. The hydraulic system adopts machinery oil #32. Replace the oil once in the first month and then regularly replace the oil every six month.

Our warranty obligation is to provide a replacement for a defective, original part covered by the warranty after we receive a proper request from the Warrantee (you) for warranty service.

Who may request service?

Only a warrantee may request service. You are a warrantee if you purchased the product from Vestil or from an authorized distributor AND Vestil has been fully paid.

Definition of "original part"?

An original part is a part used to make the product as shipped to the Warrantee.

What is a "proper request"?

A request for warranty service is proper if Vestil receives: 1) a photocopy of the <u>Customer Invoice</u> that displays the shipping date; AND 2) a <u>written request</u> for warranty service including your name and phone number. Send requests by one of the following methods:

In the written request, list the parts believed to be defective and include the address where replacements should be delivered. After Vestil receives your request for warranty service, an authorized representative will contact you to determine whether your claim is covered by the warranty. Before providing warranty service, Vestil will require you to send the entire product, or just the defective part (or parts), to its facility in Angola, IN.

What is covered under the warranty?

The warranty covers defects in the following original, dynamic parts: motors, hydraulic pumps, motor controllers, and cylinders. It also covers defects in original parts that wear under normal usage conditions ("wearing parts"), such as bearings, hoses, wheels, seals, brushes, and batteries.

How long is the warranty period?

The warranty period for original dynamic components is <u>1 year</u>. For wearing parts, the warranty period is <u>90 days</u>. Both warranty periods begin on the date Vestil ships the product to the Warrantee. If the product was purchased from an authorized distributor, the periods begin when the distributor ships the product. Vestil may, at its sole discretion, extend a warranty period for products shipped from authorized distributors by up to 30 days to account for shipping time.

If a defective part is covered by the warranty, what will Vestil do to correct the problem?

Vestil will provide an appropriate replacement for any *covered* part. An authorized representative of Vestil will contact you to discuss your claim.

What is not covered by the warranty?

The Warrantee (you) is responsible for paying labor costs and freight costs to return the product to Vestil for warranty service.

Events that automatically void this Limited Warranty.

- Misuse;
- Negligent assembly, installation, operation or repair;
- Installation/use in corrosive environments:
- Inadequate or improper maintenance;
- Damage sustained during shipping;
- · Collisions or other accidents that damage the product;
- <u>Unauthorized modifications</u>: Do not modify the product IN ANY WAY without first receiving written authorization from Vestil.
